500.0 Traffic Regulations

 - 520.1 Speed Limits

Section 1: It is hereby determined that the speed permitted by state law is greater than is safe or reasonable under conditions existing on certain streets and certain areas within the incorporated limits of the City and therefore it shall be unlawful for any person to operate a vehicle, except an official vehicle during an emergency, at a speed in excess of the speeds established by this Ordinance when signs are in place giving notice of such speed.

<u>Section 2:</u> The maximum speed on all streets or portions thereof designated as residential by the legislative body shall be twenty-five (25) miles per hour.

520.2 Bicycles

<u>Section 1:</u> Bicycles shall be operated on the streets as near to the right-hand curb or edge as practicable and the operator of a motor vehicle shall not overtake and pass a bicycle unless it can be done with reasonable safety, maintaining a space of not less that five (5) feet between the bicycle and motor vehicle.

<u>Section 2:</u> Any person operating a bicycle shall obey all traffic signs, signals and laws applicable to motor vehicles.

520.3 Trucks

<u>Section 1:</u> No truck shall be operated on the streets of this city with a load in excess of the lawful limits.

<u>Section 2:</u> No vehicle shall be operated upon any street or public way of the City unless such vehicle is so constructed or equipped with covering material to prevent the contents from escaping.

<u>Section 3:</u> The owner and the operator of any truck have the same responsibility for compliance with Sections 1 and 2 of this Ordinance.

520.4 Other Motorized Vehicles

<u>Section 1:</u> All motorized vehicles operated within the city limits shall comply with State of Kentucky laws.

Section 2: No motorized vehicle may be operated upon any sidewalk in the City.

Section 3: Any person operating a motorized vehicle shall obey all traffic signs, signals and laws applicable to motor vehicles.

 - 530.1 Signs and Signals

<u>Section 1:</u> Stop or yield signs shall be posted on such streets and at any intersections the legislative body shall determine are necessary for proper traffic control.

Section 2: All vehicular traffic shall obey the traffic signs and signals as set forth in KRS Chapter 189.

- 540.0 Parking, Stopping and Meters
 - 540.1 Parking Regulations

<u>Section 1:</u> No person shall park, stop or leave standing, any vehicle except when necessary to avoid conflict with traffic or in compliance with directions of a police officer or traffic control device.

A. In any intersection or within thirty (30) feet thereof.

B. Within thirty (30) feet of a traffic signal or sign on the approaching side.

C. At any place where the standing of a vehicle will reduce the usable width of the roadway for moving traffic to less than sixteen (16) feet.

D. At any place where the vehicle would block the use of a driveway.

E. On or across any sidewalk or upon the unpaved portion of any public right-of-way within the City.

F. At any place where official signs prohibit parking.

<u>Section 2:</u> No vehicle shall be parked with its left side next to the edge of the roadway, except on one-way streets.

<u>Section 3:</u> It shall be unlawful to park any motor vehicle on any private property without the consent of the owner or occupant of the property, or upon any unpaved area of private property.

Section 4: No person shall park a vehicle upon any street for the purpose of:

A. Displaying such vehicle for sale.

B. Washing, greasing, painting or repairing such vehicle, except repairs necessitated by an emergency.

<u>Section 5:</u> No person shall park any vehicle on any street for a period of time longer than ten (10) minutes between the hours of 2:00 AM and 5:00 AM of any day.

<u>Section 6:</u> The fact that any automobile which is illegally parked is registered in the name of a person, firm or corporation shall be considered prima facie proof that such person was in control of the automobile at the time of such parking.

Section 7: No vehicle shall be parked within ten (10) feet of any fire hydrant.

Section 8: The restriction contained herein shall not apply to emergency or police vehicles when in use on official business or pursuant to KRS 189.940.

<u>Section 9:</u> No marked business vehicles or commercial vehicles of any kind shall be parked regularly on any property at any time, except within a garage.

590.0 Penalties

590.1 Fines for Speeding

The fines for speeding in violation of Code Section 520.1 shall be those fines specified in KRS 189.394, as amended.

590.2 Penalties

1. Any person who shall violate Code Section 520.2 or Code Section 520.4 shall be fined no less than ten (\$10.00) dollars nor more than one hundred (\$100.00) dollars.

2. Any person who shall violate Code Section 520.3, Section 1., shall be fined as specified in KRS 189.990(2), as amended.

3. Any person who shall violate Code Section 520.3, Section 2., shall be fined not less than twenty (\$20.00) dollars nor more than one hundred (\$100.00) dollars for each offense.

4. Any person who shall violate Code Section 530.1 shall be fined as specified in KRS 189.990, as amended.

5. Any person who shall violate Code Section 540.1 shall be fined not less than twenty (\$20.00) dollars nor more than one hundred (\$100.00) dollars for each offense.

6. Any person who shall violate any provision of this Code for which no penalty is otherwise provided for herein shall be fined not more than five hundred (\$500.00) dollars or imprisoned for not more than ninety (90) days, or both.

7. Where any fine provided for in Kentucky Revised Statutes is more than the fine provided for herein for the same conduct, such fine shall be that specified in Kentucky Revised Statutes, as amended.

8. Any continuing violation of this Code of Ordinances shall be considered a separate offense for each day that such violation continues, and a separate penalty may be imposed therefore.
